

HONOR POLICY – Must follow all policies and procedures of the ministry area in which you serve. You are a steward of responsibility not an independent volunteer. (James 4:17)

COMMUNICATE WITH LEADERSHIP – If anything happens in the ministry environment that your leader needs to know about, let them know immediately.

ATTEND WORSHIP SERVICES – Be a committed part of the church family through regular worship attendance and faithful participation in a discipleship community. (Hebrews 10:24-25)



CULTIVATE A TEACHABLE SPIRIT - Pursue a servant-hearted humility (1 Peter 5:5-7) maintaining a teachable spirit in accordance with Scripture. (Philippians 2:3-8)

AFFIRM THE BIBLICAL VIEW OF MARRIAGE, GENDER, AND BEHAVIOR - Warren honors and affirms marriage as established by God—a union between one man and one woman. (Genesis 2:24; Ephesians 5:31) In accordance with Scripture, sexual intimacy and sexual activity is appropriate only within the marriage relationship. (1 Corinthians 7:2; Hebrews 13:4) Warren believes God has created two distinct genders, male and female, each created within God's perfect design. (Genesis 1:27; Matthew 19:4) To this end, all sexual preference and practice outside of these parameters dishonors God, His Word and His church. (1 Thessalonians 4:1-8)
