

RULES for playing PICKLEBALL




1 PADDLE QUEUE FOR 3 COURTS

The left most paddle is next to play. When placing paddles into the queue, place them to the right of others already in line.

As paddles exit the queue, players may gently shift the remaining paddles to the left, ensure order is maintained.


Placing paddles ahead of others is prohibited. Players may move their *own* paddle to the *end* of the line, but never in front of another paddle.

Players should stand near the queue so they can move to the court promptly when called. Should a player miss their turn, allow the paddle to remain at the front of the queue.



MIXED SKILL, AGE, AND GENDER

Private or exclusive play is prohibited. Open play allows for players of varying skill, age and gender to play together on the same court. Pickleball activities at Warren Church are considered fellowship purposes only.



2 CONSECUTIVE GAMES

When others are waiting to play, the losing team will place their paddles at the end of the queue. The winning team may remain on the court.

The winning team can choose to stay together as a team, or play against each other with the next 2 players from the queue.

Win or lose, players cannot play more than 2 games in a row before returning to the queue.

If a combination of winners and losers come off the same court, allow the winners to place their paddles in the queue before the losing team.
