A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another... (John 13:34)

- Internal: How was your week...anything new?! How was your walk with the Lord this week?
- External: Is there any individual or family who is struggling or needs encouragement from us?

TRUTH

Let the word of God dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another... (Col. 3:16)

- 1. When you reflect on the message from Sunday, what most resonated with you?
- 2. Let's read the final two chapters of the Bible, chapters 21 and 22. Let's take a moment to compare the creation story in Genesis to the New Creation in Revelation. What is similar and what is different? [Examples: Heaven, Earth, Sun, Night, Seas, Curse, Death, Paradise, Pain, Devil.]
- 3. In chapter 21, verse 3 says, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man." What does this say about God? Is this a new idea in the Bible?
- 4. Do we actually see God in Heaven? How does chapter 22 answer this finally?
- 5. Paul often refers to a "heavenly citizenship' (Phil 3), "a mind set on things above" (Col. 3). Ecclesiastes 3:11 says God "has put eternity in their hearts." How does this text help shape our day-to-day actions?
- 6. What do you most long for in heaven? What verse(s) in these chapters bring you the most hope?
- 7. As you close the book of Revelation, what impacted you the most?

GREAT COMMISSION

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations... (Matt. 28:19-20)

- Did you disciple your family well this week? Is Jesus the reason for your hope in your daily activity?

CONFESSION/PRAYER/REPENTANCE

But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today,"... (Heb. 3:12-14)

- Confession is agreeing with God about our sin according to the Scriptures. Is there anything you want to confess before the group? [apathy, idolatry, selfishness, jealousy, anger, envy]
- Let's pray, asking God to help us apply His word to our lives, putting to death sinful desires.
