

WSF Pickleball FAQ

Q: What is Open Play and how does it work?

Open Play welcomes all skill levels to connect, play, and learn together in an inclusive environment. Courts are not divided by skill level. Open Play is unhosted and available during the following times:

Mondays: 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM (Unhosted)

Tuesdays: 1:30 PM – 3:30 PM (Unhosted)

Wednesdays: 1:30 PM – 3:30 PM (Unhosted)

Thursdays: 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM (Unhosted)

Open Play Queue Rules:

- If you win your first game, you may stay on the court to play a second game before returning to the queue.
- There is no obligation to stay with your partner.
- If you lose your game, return to the queue and await your next turn.
- At any time, you are welcome to skip your turn if you prefer.

These guidelines ensure everyone has a fair opportunity to play and enjoy their time on the courts.

Q: Can I rent or reserve a court?

Yes, one court is available for rent on Monday, Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Court reservations can be made up to **14 days in advance**. The member making the reservation may invite non-members to join the group. After these hours, the court opens for general play. The front desk will be happy to assist you with reservations. Refunds require 24 hour advance notice.

Q: Can I bring a guest to play?

Yes, guests are welcome! They must check in at the front desk before playing. Guests can enjoy Open Play free of charge for their first two visits.

Q: Do I need to bring my own balls?

Yes, for Open Play, bring your own paddle and balls. Balls are provided for lessons, clinics, and leagues. Premium Selkirk demo paddles are also available for you to try.

Q: I want to learn or improve my game. What are my options?

Private Lessons: Private lessons offer personalized instruction tailored to your needs. Lessons are one hour long and available during Open Play hours:

Members can invite as many people as they'd like to join the lesson, including non-members to split the cost. Sign up at the front desk and coordinate with Perry at 762-333-1840 (text preferred) to schedule your lesson(s).

Group Clinic (Wednesdays): 12:30 PM – 3:30 PM. Clinics focus on practicing and enhancing skills. Open to all skill levels. Membership not required.

Class size is limited to 10 participants, so reserve early. Players can sign up at the front desk or register online at <https://warren.church/ministries/wsf/>
