4 LONGO PEOPLE | UNREACHED PEOPLE



An unreached people group is a group of people who don't have any Christian communities with enough people and resources to help spread the Gospel to them without outside sources. It's estimated that out of the 8.08 billion people living on Earth today, 3.42 billion of them live in unreached people groups with limited or no access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Here at Warren, we have a desire to reach the unreached Longo people with Gospel of Jesus. The Longo live in north-central Uganda. They are influenced by traditional beliefs, which still play a big role in their religious lives. The Longo people mostly hunt, farm, and raise livestock. They speak the Longo language. There are about 2,964,000 Longo people.

- The Gospel to be proclaimed among them.
- Workers to be sent to the Longo.
- The spiritual bondages of the people to be broken, and that they would find freedom in Christ.
- Healthy churches to be planted among them.
- Pastor Paul and his family; local Longo believers to be strong in their faith

5 SOUTHEAST ASIA



The Buffalo People are a deeply communal and resilient group Indonesia. With 99.9% identifying as Muslim, following Jesus comes at a high personal and social cost. We are part of a small team that lives among them—learning culture, building trust, and sowing seeds of the gospel. Visible fruit is rare, but God is at work beneath the surface

- The Buffalo People—that their hearts would be open to truth, and that the cost of following Jesus would be met with His peace and presence.
- The team—for courage and endurance to keep sowing faithfully, even when progress feels slow and unseen.
- The existing church—that believers from other tribes already living among the Buffalo People would see beyond church traditions and reach out across cultures with love.
- More laborers—with over five-million people in this region and only a handful reaching out, ask the Lord to send more workers into this field.

6 JESUS IS KING CHURCH | BRUNSWICK, ME



"We are engaged in focusing on our church, the community, and in connection with other local churches. Inwardly, Jesus is deepening personal walks with Him and keeping Christ at the center of our family. Toward our church, I teach and preach the Word three days a week, while also providing pastoral care to individuals. In the community, we have established several ministries, including a Gospel outreach addressing abortion, a homeless ministry that distributes clothing and supplies, and regular street evangelism, encouraging congregants to share Christ with others. Additionally, I am connected with many Gospel-minded pastors in Maine, which has greatly encouraged our church and fostered a sense of community." -Pastor Andrade

7 KENYA | WILLIS FAMILY

 Church. This congregation is receptive to welcoming refugees but needs guidance and direction.

"We work with the South Sudanese refugees in Kawangware Slum, Nairobi. Casey leads a weekly Bible study for women whose husbands are in South Sudan seeking work. Chris connects these women to Baptist Church and has Riruta started a feeding program funded by Send Relief. In 2024, Chris became a Logistics Consultant for Uganda and Rwanda, assisting missionaries with visas and vehicles. This role also allows him to direct a nursery school Rhino Camp, supporting the refugee community with hope and assistance in Jesus' name"

Many target groups lack a written language, so we aim to teach literacy and translate the Bible to ensure the church thrives beyond one generation. While teaching literacy, we will evangelize and teach the Bible chronologically. Our ultimate goal is to establish a self-sustaining, mature church with biblical leadership, a process that can take 8 to 20+ years. In Brazil, we have spent two years learning Portuguese. Eli will teach God's Word and maintain team resources, while Jessica will learn both Portuguese and the tribal language, homeschool our children, and focus on literacy and discipleship for women. 11 BETTER TOGETHER FOSTER CARE



Pray for:

The Better Together Foster Care Ministry supports over 100 children and seventeen foster families in the CSRA, with seven more families on a waitlist. They form care teams of 5 volunteers to deliver weekly meals and essential items provide like Bibles, diapers, and bedding from their care closet. During Christmas. church groups sponsor families with gifts for each child and parent. The ministry also hosts events for social workers, such as the Better Together Brunch and a Kit Drive for school supplies and sanitary products. Additionally, they assist biological families in reuniting with their children by providing essential items and a Transportation Team to set up beds and share the Gospel.

12 CENTRAL ASIA



"We are working to catalyze movements among Muslims and Hindus in Central and South Asia. As we coach local leaders to follow the principles that Jesus used in Luke 10, they are going out among the lost,

finding people of peace, along with starting discovery groups and teaching them to obey all that Jesus commanded (Matthew 28:16-20). This year we have seen over 1,000 lost people in 80+ groups discovering who Jesus is for the first time by listening to stories from the Word of God and immediately putting them into practice. Lives are being radically changed as they learn to obey Jesus and share His truth with their lost family and friends. In these security-sensitive areas, we are beginning to see disciples who are making disciples who are making more disciples. (2 Timothy 2:2)"

- Our steadfastness as we are experiencing an increase in spiritual
 warfare both on location and in our family. Our local teammates have
 experienced betrayal, extortion, sicknesses, and police interference.
 Our family has been hit with illnesses and broken bones as well as
 feeling the pressure of spiritual attacks. Pray that we would remain
 rooted in the Word and close to Jesus in the face of intense spiritual
 warfare.
- Healthy families, strong marriages, wise parenting, and boldness for us and our local teammates.
- Courage to move forward in making disciples even when it is hard (Hebrews 12:1-2).

It recognizes and reinforces the constitutionally protected right of parents to direct the religious education of their children.

The mission in Eswatini is to create tangible expressions of God's kingdom by caring for children's physical, emotional, and spiritual needs at Timbutini and Ntabas CarePoints. As we invest in each child, we also begin to disciple the surrounding communities, creating a ripple effect that can transform the region and, ultimately, the nation. Eswatini faces immense challenges, including the world's highest adult HIV prevalence rate of 28.8%, leaving many children orphaned and the nation deeply affected. Known as the "Nation of Orphans," it has lost generations of parents, leaders, and workers to HIV/AIDS. Through our partnership with Adventures in Missions, we are committed to providing love, support, and discipleship to these children. We are deeply grateful for your prayers for our partners and their work. Together, we believe in restoring hope and building a brighter future for Eswatini.

Team members lead Bible studies for men and women within their cell blocks, offer free Bibles, and provide a comprehensive index of local resources that can help inmates and their families more successfully transition to life together on the outside. Since its inception in 2015, volunteers have shared the Good News in over 3,800 scheduled jail visits attended by nearly 43,000 detainees. Our newest effort is focused on the area of Youth Development and Youth Detention centers reaching out with the Gospel to young offenders in the Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice facilities. Volunteers lead Bible discussions and provide academic tutoring.
