# Key attributes of a Leader

- **Vision**- way to understand the system and how it could work better
- **Discrimination**- evaluate opportunities and focus on the best ones
- **Strategic thinking**- Decide which plans will meet objectives
- **Commitment**- dedication to the process and/or outcome
- **Inspirational communication**- share the vision to inspire team and stakeholders

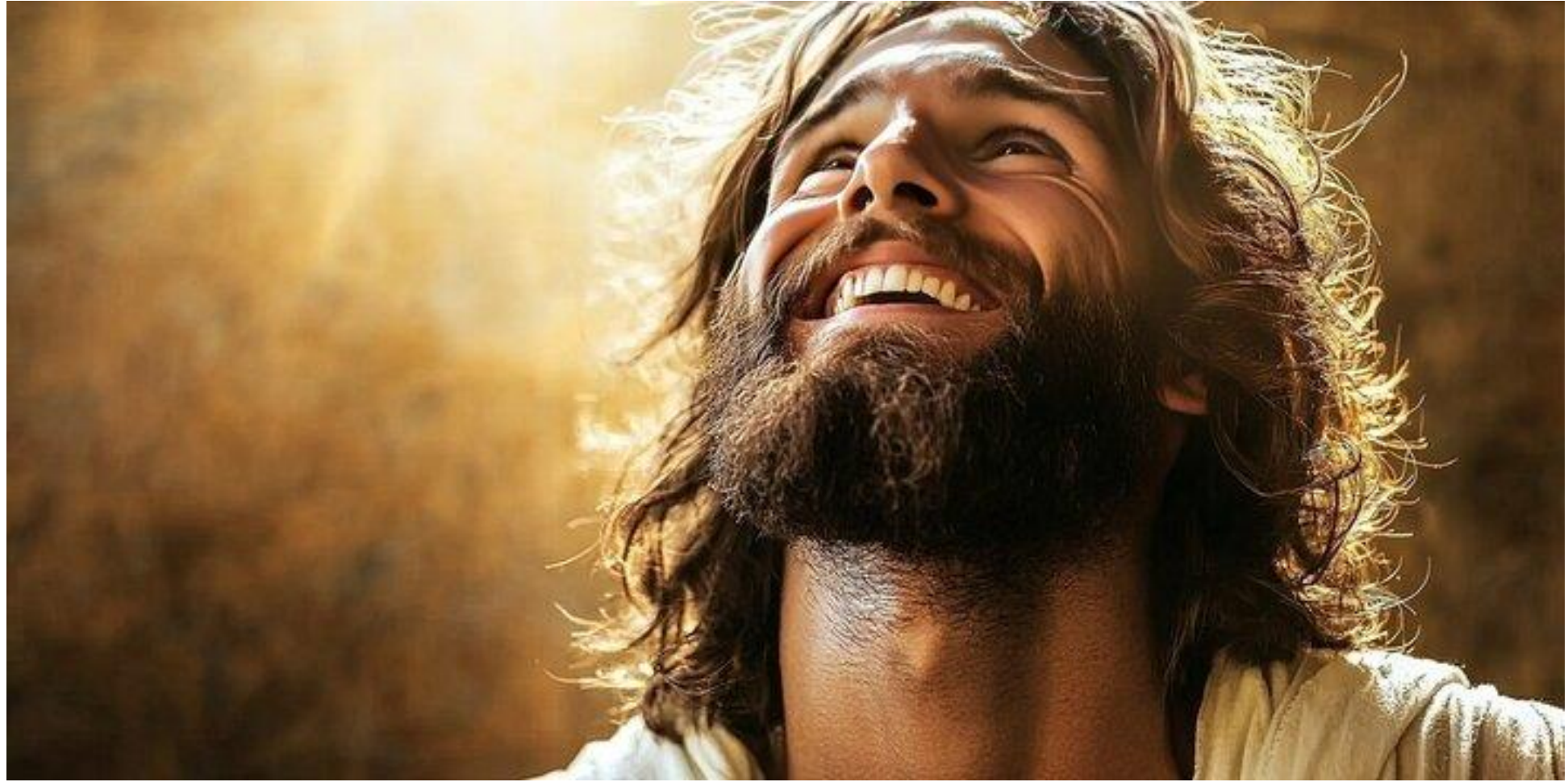
This is how a leader is described in the workplace...

**The most effective leaders:**

- 1. Invest in strengths** - provide professional development and assign tasks based on strengths.
- 2. Surround themselves with diverse team members** - people with different skills, backgrounds, training, etc.
- 3. Understand their followers needs-** Learning and supporting followers' goals, guiding development of new skill sets


