South Sudanese women are seeking refuge in the Kawangware slum of Nairobi. Chris and Casey Willis, missionaries with the IMB, work closely with these women, many of whose husbands remain in South Sudan in search of work. Casey leads a weekly Bible study, while Chris helps connect these women to a local church in their community, Riruta Baptist Church. Farm training and a feeding program are central ways they meet both practical and spiritual needs. In addition, Chris serves as a Logistics Consultant for Uganda and Rwanda, extending their reach. Through this role, they provide vital support to other missionaries and help oversee a nursery school in a refugee camp. The physical care they offer in the name of Jesus shines as a bright light of hope, one that is found in Him alone.

- *Our family to maintain a healthy, Christ-centered balance between work, school, and family life.*
- *Open doors for the gospel to move forward in our ministry through ESL in the Riruta slum with refugee women in Nairobi throughout 2026, and through farm training in partnership with WBC at a school in Rhino Camp this July.*

RELEASED TIME BIBLE EDUCATION

There is nothing quite like a mid-day field trip away from school. With parental approval, public schools release students for part of the school day to attend off-site religious instruction offered by a private sponsoring group. Released Time Bible Education recognizes and reinforces the constitutionally protected right of parents to direct the religious education of their children.

- *A smooth transition as we add 2nd grade classes across eight programs (a minimum increase of 160 new students each week).*
- *Continued growth of the volunteer base needed to support increased enrollment.*
- *God's hedge of protection over the ministry as a whole—both locally and nationally (the enemy does not like what we are doing).*

Make way for this high-powered, after-school Bible club in public schools, designed for children ages 5–12. As a ministry of Child Evangelism Fellowship, Good News Clubs are active across the nation and in 10 local public schools, each sponsored by a local church. These churches send trained volunteers to lead the one-hour program, which includes a Bible lesson, songs, Scripture memory, a missions story, review games, and an invitation to receive Christ.



Pray For:

- *Praise God for 32 salvations and 461 children reached with the Gospel this school year.*
- *Two more schools to start a Good News Club by September 2026.*
- *Two more churches and volunteers (Matthew 9:37–38).*
- *A children's ministry to begin at Fort Gordon.*

Hope Women's Center offers confidential support to women and families in the CSRA and surrounding areas who are facing difficult life decisions, including unplanned pregnancies. They provide hope, help, and healing through compassionate care and guidance. They strive to be a haven for their patients by offering honest, grace-filled education in a judgment-free environment, empowering women to make informed decisions. Their work is driven by a deep care and concern for everyone who walks through their doors.

CENTRAL ASIA



Underground and out of sight, we are seeing disciples make disciples who then make more disciples. A movement is growing among Muslims and Hindus in Central and South Asia. Local leaders are being coached to follow Jesus' model in Luke 10: finding people of peace, starting discovery groups, and teaching obedience to His commands. Lives are being transformed as people follow Jesus and share Him with their families and friends.

Pray for:

- *Steadfast faith amid spiritual warfare, staying rooted in the Word and close to Jesus.*
- *Courage to keep making disciples, even when it's hard.*
- *People sharing their faith and starting new groups.*
- *Deep love for Jesus and obedience that bears fruit for God's glory.*

The unreached in nearly unreachable places are still being reached. Our partners in South Asia are equipping churches to become disciple-making, church-planting churches. The work faces both spiritual barriers and difficult terrain. From busy city streets to remote mountain trails, the gospel is carried and the church is formed.

SOUTH ASIA



Pray For:

- *The newly elected government to take a more moderate position on religious freedom for all faiths in South Asia.*
- *Wisdom as we select and appoint new church planters from among recent graduates of the training program.*
- *God to provide a new cohort of young, potential church planters to enter the training course being offered in three regions of the country.*

BRAZIL

ELLIOTT FAMILY

Driven by Paul's calling in Romans 15:20, the Elliott family serves in overseas missions among unreached people groups. Many of the communities they serve have no written language, so the Elliotts focus on literacy development and Bible translation, laying a foundation for God's Word to take root for generations to come. Alongside literacy training, they share the Gospel and teach the Bible chronologically. Their long-term vision is to see a healthy, self-sustaining church led by trained local believers, a faithful work that often unfolds over 8 to 20+ years.

Pray For:

- *Continued progress in language and cultural studies.*
- *The upcoming intensive training course with the Y people in June.*
- *The house-building project, as we have been unable to return to our home in the village due to political opposition.*

HONDURAS

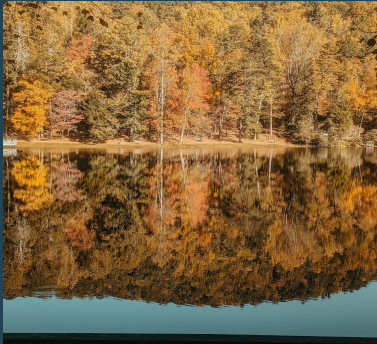
Honduras is one of the poorest countries in the Western Hemisphere. Another major challenge is the rampant crime and violence driven by gang activity and drug cartels. Our desire is to develop pastors and church leaders who are faithful to Christ, skilled in teaching the Scriptures, and committed to actively expressing God's love in their communities, with a dedication to training others who will do the same. Our training programs are strategically designed to address the challenges that poverty presents, particularly the barriers that prevent many pastors from receiving formal education.

Pray For:

- *God's protection and provision for the church leaders in five Lenca villages. They have been facing opposition in their communities. Some of it has taken the form of harmful gossip, and in a few cases, farm animals have been poisoned and crops intentionally damaged.*
- *God's leading and provision as we pursue sustainable community development projects in these villages, seeking long-term ways to strengthen their wellbeing.*
- *Nearly 100 pastors and church leaders whom the World Reach team is training at four different sites across Honduras. Pray that they would grow not only in biblical knowledge but also in their walk with God.*

SOUTHEAST ASIA

On the southern half of the island where the Buffalo people live, there are over 20 additional unreached people groups totaling more than 4.5 million people. These distinct tribes have very little access to the gospel of Jesus Christ. Many have no known followers of Christ and no strategic Christian presence (churches or sent-out workers) laboring among them to make the Gospel known. Partners in Southeast Asia are currently working to identify, train, and send out workers to serve among each of these 20+ tribes.

Pray For:

- *God to call out those willing to be sent to these 20+ people groups to bring them the good news of Jesus (Romans 10:8–18).*
- *God to give favor to our partners serving in Southeast Asia as they develop relationships with local churches, seminaries, and Christian universities to identify Spirit-filled candidates to send.*
- *God to pour out His mercy on these 20+ unreached people groups, grant them access to the saving gospel of Christ, and call out from among them a people for Himself (Isaiah 62:11–12).*

MCCOLLUM FAMILY

Amid a culture driven by the pursuit of peace, lasting peace still eludes many, a peace and rest that only Jesus can provide. Ian and Gabi McCollum live and serve in Hiroshima, where they have a deep love and passion for the Japanese people. They are missionary church planters with Mustard Seed Church, serving primarily in worship and discipleship. They focus on community outreach through ESL, sports, and children's ministry, seeking to bridge cultural gaps as a means of leading the lost to the cross.

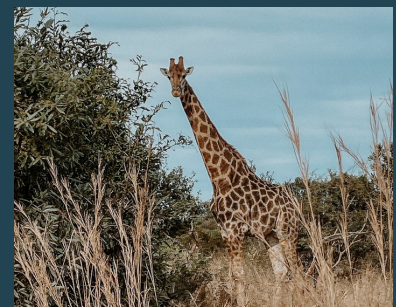
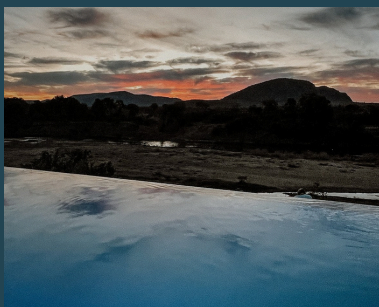

ITEC (Indigenous People’s Technology & Education Center) exists to equip indigenous Christ-followers with practical tools, training, and skills that open new doors for sharing the Gospel and fulfilling the Great Commission. Rather than doing ministry short-term trips, ITEC partners with local churches and believers, developing training programs that empower them to meet both physical and spiritual needs in their own context and to continue ministry long after teams leave.

Through this “train-the-trainer” model, ITEC fosters sustainable, interdependent mission engagement, helping disciple-makers multiply their impact around the world.

Pray For:

- *Wisdom in how to train Christ followers in these countries without creating unnecessary risk for them or for our training teams.*
- *Discernment as we reschedule postponed trips and plan new trips to countries affected by the unrest.*

T-Net (Teleo Network) exists to help finish the Great Commission by raising up indigenous leaders who multiply disciple-makers and initiate church-planting movements among all nations. Founded in 1992, T-Net now serves in over 40 countries, training thousands of pastors and leaders to revitalize existing churches and plant new ones through a reproducible, biblically- grounded, disciple-making process rooted in Jesus’ command in Matthew 28. T-Net equips local leaders to lead, fund, and expand gospel movements within their own nations, resulting in sustainable, Spirit-led transformation that spreads far beyond borders. -

ZAMBIA

From farm to pulpit the church in Zambia is formed. We have had the opportunity to equip the church in Chongwe with the Foundations of Farming training. Believers use this training not only for sustainability of life but also as a means to reach the lost in their community. Beyond the farm is the Lusekelo Missions/Skills Training Center which offers basic theological training to those called into pastoral ministry, discipleship training, and other general life skills training.
